- 1606 1669 Rembrandt van Rijn (REM-brant van RIEN) Dutch draughtsman, painter, and printmaker.
- 1760 1849 **Katsushika Hokusai** (cot-soo-shee-ka ho-koo-sigh)

  Japanese artist, ukiyo-e painter and printmaker.
- 1822 1899 Rosa Bonheur (boe-NER) French painter, animalière, and sculptor.
- 1834 1917 Edgar Degas (deh-GAH) French painter and sculptor.
- 1836 1910 Winslow Homer American painter and printmaker.
- 1839 1906 Paul Cézanne (say-ZAHN) French painter.
- 1840 1926 Claude Monet (moe-NAY) French painter.
- 1841 1919 Pierre Auguste Renoir (aw-GOOST ren-WAHR) French painter.
- 1844 1910 Henri Rousseau (ahn-REE roo-SO) French painter.
- 1844 1926 Mary Cassatt (kuh- SAHT) American painter and printmaker.
- 1848 1903 Paul Gauguin (go-GAN) French painter.
- 1853 1890 Vincent Van Gogh (van- Go) Dutch painter.
- 1859 1891 Georges Seurat (ser-AH) French painter and draftsman.
- 1861 1909 Frederic Remington (REM-ing-tun) American illustrator, painter, sculptor and writer.
- 1862 1918 Gustav Klimt (goos'täf klimt) Austrian painter.
- 1864 1901 Henri de Toulouse-Lautrec (ahn-REE de too-LOOZ lah-TREK) French painter, printmaker, draughtsman and illustrator.

- 1869 1954 **Henri Matisse** (ahn-REE mah-TEECE) French painter, draughtsman, printmaker, and sculptor.
- 1872 1944 Piet Mondrian (peet MOAN-dree-ahn) Dutch painter.
- 1879 1940 Paul Klee (Klay) German and Swiss painter.
- 1881 1973 Pablo Picasso (pe-KAH-so) Spanish painter, sculptor, printmaker, ceramicist, stage designer, poet and playwright.
- 1882 1967 Edward Hopper American painter and printmaker.
- 1887 1980 Maria Martinez (mar-TEE-nez) American Pueblo potter.
- 1887 1985 Marc Chagall (shah-GAHL) Russian born Jewish painter, illustrator.

  Artistic in many mediums: stained glass, stage sets ceramics, tapestries and fine art prints.
- 1887 1986 Georgia O'Keeffe (oh-KEEF) American painter.
- 1891 1942 **Grant Wood** American painter.
- 1893 1983 Joan Miró (whan mee-ROE) Spanish painter, sculptor, and ceramicist.
- 1894 1978 Norman Rockwell American author, painter and illustrator.
- 1898 1972 M.C. Escher (esh'ur) Dutch graphic artist who made mathematically inspired woodcuts, lithographs, and mezzotints.
- 1898 1976 Alexander Calder (KAWL-DER) American painter, sculptor (mobiles).
- 1907 1954 Frida Kahlo (free-duh KAH-loe) Mexican painter (self-portraits).
- 1917 2000 Jacob Lawrence (LAW-rence) American painter (African American lives) storyteller, educator.
- 1928 1987 Andy Warhol (WAR-hall) American painter (pop art).
- 1930 => Faith Ringgold (RING-gold) American painter and story quilter.
