**Ploughing in the Nivernais** was first exhibited at the Salon of 1848, and is now in the Musée d'Orsay in Paris.

**The Horse Fair** was exhibited at the Salon of 1853 (finished in 1855) and is now in the Metropolitan Museum of Art, in New York City.


Due to a tendency in to locate Bonheur as a proto-Feminist and as a pivotal figure for Queer theory, she is perhaps most famous today because she was known for wearing men's clothing, smoking and living together with women. She lived for over forty years with her childhood friend Nathalie Micas. In the final year of her life she became close with Anna Klumpke, the author of her "autobiography".




