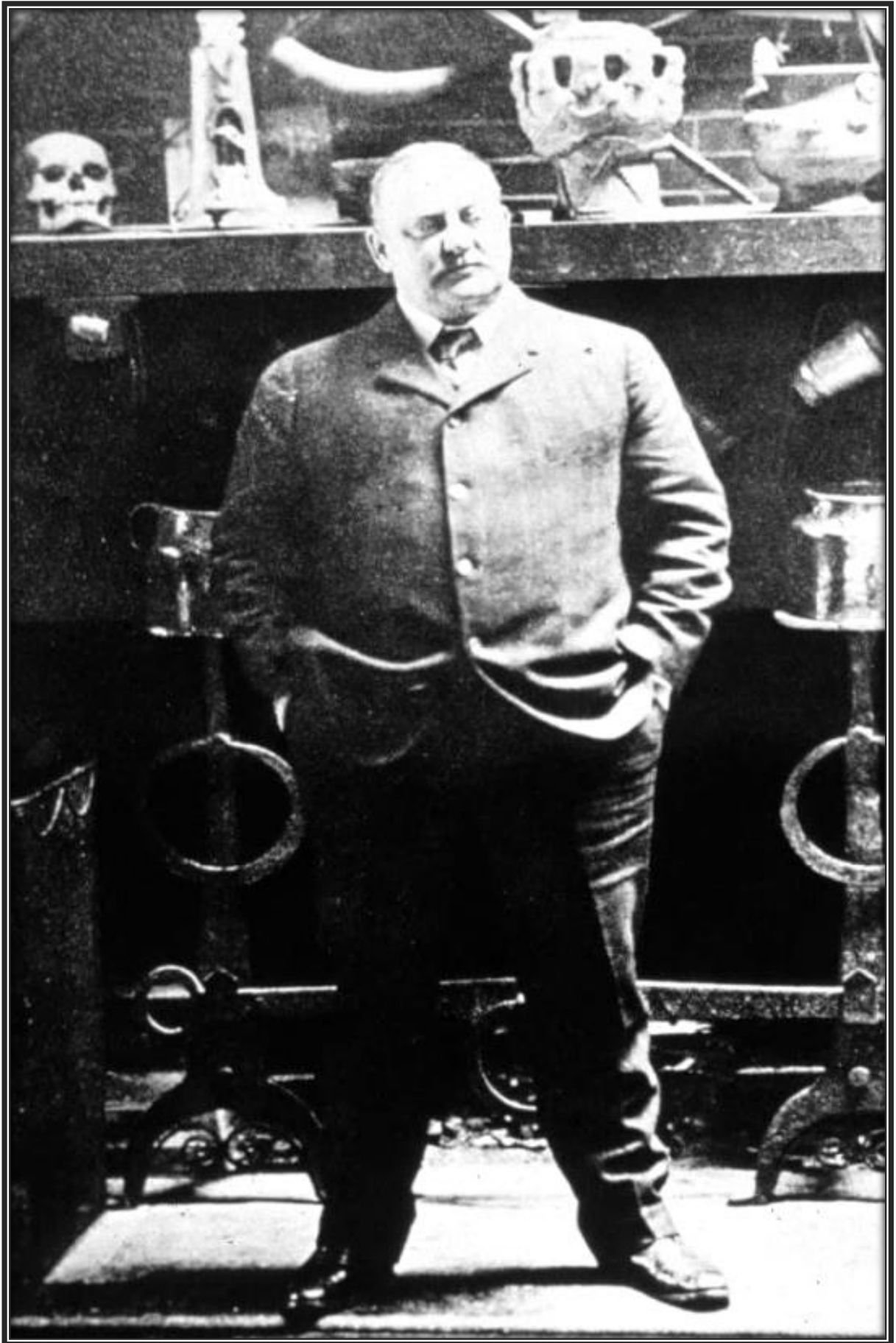

Father: Colonel in the Civil War, Newspaper editor, trained horses as a hobby.

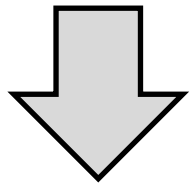
Great grandfather: Saddlemaker. Family: fine horsemen.

Only child. Active, large, strong. Poor student. Began to draw.

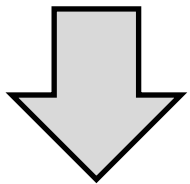

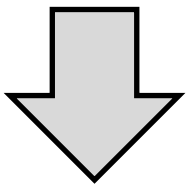

Leaves Yale to Care for Dad.



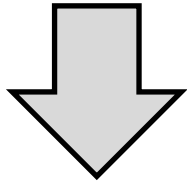

First Trip West.



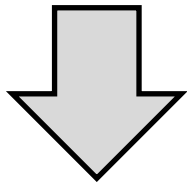

Sheep Ranching, Hardware store, Saloon – fails.



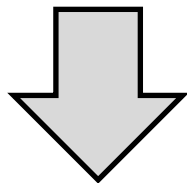

Marries Eva. Loses Eva. Reunites with Eva.



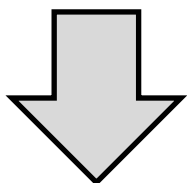

Illustrator Career Success: Full Page – Harpers Weekly.



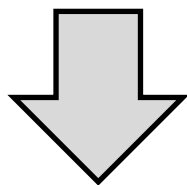

Arizona. Canada.



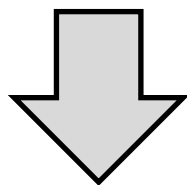

Theodore Roosevelt book.



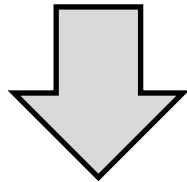

Two Postage Stamps. Harper's Promo Campaign.



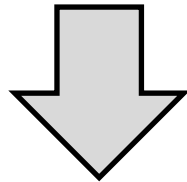
